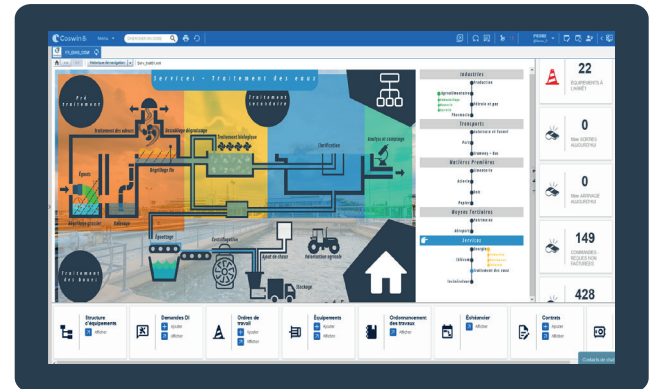

EYDAP S.A., the **Athens Water and Sewerage Company**, is the **largest Greek company in its sector** in Greece. It serves approximately 4 400 000 clients (2 160 000 water meters) whereas the length of the water pipes is of 14 000 km. The sanitation sector serves 3 500 000 residents with a sewer system extending over about 9 500 km.

- potable water pump stations

Municipal Solid Waste Treatment Plant of Epirus region, Greece

The solid waste treatment plant in the Epirus region is **the first unit of this kind in Greece to produce biogas from municipal solid waste**. It is **one of the most modern waste treatment plant in Europe**. At least 17 000 tons of useful materials are recycled each year, thus contributing to the achievement of the national recycling objectives.

The plant produces 10 800 of green energy each year, which can meet the needs of 3 000 families while avoiding 12 000 tons of carbon dioxide emissions. 25 000 tons of compost are produced each year.

All equipment (processing equipment, utilities, and forklifts) **are managed through Coswin** (preventive maintenance). An interface with the ERP of the company exists for the management of the warehouse items.
